

Pavement Evaluation for Anheuser-Busch



In 2007, Applied Pavement Technology, Inc. (APTech) was hired by Anheuser-Busch, Inc. and Ventura Engineering to evaluate the pavement infrastructure at the Anheuser-Busch plant in Columbus, Ohio. The purpose of the evaluation was confirm the extent and cause of existing pavement performance problems, as well as to propose remedies for the existing issues and identify other pavement issues that might need to be addressed during pavement rehabilitation.

APTech completed a visual pavement inspection and reviewed existing designs based on the observed conditions, the anticipated traffic loadings, and other relevant inputs to the pavement design process. APTech's findings were summarized in a memo and included recommendations for modifications to the design and project scope that would improve the long-term performance of the pavement repairs.
